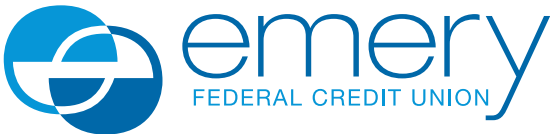

Scholarship - Rules and Regulations

Scholarship Amount

Three \$1,000 and two \$500 scholarships will be awarded annually for attending either a two or four year accredited college or university.

Eligibility

- APPLICANT MUST BE AN ACTIVE EMERY FEDERAL CREDIT UNION MEMBER.
- Must be planning to attend a two or four year college in the fall as a full time student.
- Emery Federal Credit Union Employees, Board Member and their immediate families are not eligible.

Criteria For Winning the Scholarship

The Scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Academic achievement
- Community involvement
- Financial need
- Completion of a 300-word essay explaining why the Credit Union is important to their family and themselves.
- Letters of recommendation – minimum of three

Award Procedures

- Scholarship check will be made payable to the recipient at the beginning of each term. To receive the check, send a copy of the original bill and/or a list of classes to: Scholarship Emery FCU to the address below.
- At the end of the term, send a copy of an official report card to Scholarship Emery FCU.
- Grade point average must be 2.5 or greater

Application Process

To apply you must complete an Emery Federal Credit Union Scholarship Application.
